

## SA NT DATALINK DISPUTE MANAGEMENT PROCESSES

SA NT DataLink seeks to resolve issues regarding a project managed by SA NT DataLink staff as speedily and as fairly as possible. In doing so, it always seeks to ensure its practices and processes are consistent with its principles and the SA NT DataLink Joint Venture Agreement under which it is established.

SA NT DataLink has responsibilities and legal obligations to a number of organisations. These include:

- 1. The University of South Australia in relation to its Client Services staff.
- 2. The Department of Health and Ageing in relation to its Data Linkage Unit staff.
- 3. The South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute (SAHMRI) because of its location in SAHMRI building. As a part of the SAHMRI community, it is also expected to manage these in a manner consistent with SAHMRI's principles.
- 4. Those organisations who have provided data to SA NT DataLink.
